This was a fundraiser for Rainbow Over Wisconsin and the goal was to raise at least \$2000.00 which would be used to purchase condoms in conjunction with ARCW as has been done the past two years. These condoms are then distributed at all the LGBT bars in Northeastern Wisconsin. We are thrilled to report \$2400.00 was raised, so we exceeded our expectations. Thank you to the businesses who ran ads in the program (100%) of the ad money was donated to ROW) and guest bartenders some from ROW itself who gave up their tips as a donation. Thanks to the Za's employees who pulled it off beautifully again this year and of course the customers who shelled out three bucks at the door, then donated more in tips all night long. I should also note this past weekend we raised another \$600 for ROW in honor of Ken Rohde & Terry Tetzlaff's birthday. Combined with Turnabout and our earlier Man of the Year party, Za's raised \$3700.00 for ROW this year! We thank the generous customers.

Next week a new publication will launch for the Wisconsin LGBT Community called *Probe*. I wasn't too happy to learn this since as many know, the three current publications struggle to stay in business, but I do wish them my best. I am perhaps a little envious they will be able to have more room for articles written by local people than I have been able to make room for not to mention the struggle to get people to write for Quest. I do not know the distribution plans for the publication yet, but they should be out by the middle of December with the first issue.

In case it hasn't hit you yet, the end of this century and the beginning of the next happens this New Year's Eve. Technically it's not the beginning of the new millennium until 2001, but it will be a new century and this New Year's is really something special. Most bars will be planning something extra in celebration, so if you stay home this year, shame on you! You don't have to get shit-faced-drunk, but you should go out and celebrate with the rest of us! If the bar scene isn't your thing and you live in the Fox Valley area, Positive Voice will be hosting New Year's Eve at Liberty Hall again this year. The Pink Party will be going on in Madison. (It's the closest thing Wisconsin gets to a true Circuit Party.)

Finally a bit of business relating to Quest. Our Website was moved recently to a new company and in the process, Internic, the national registry of Websites somehow delayed the transfer. 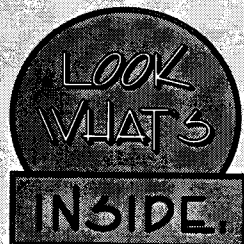

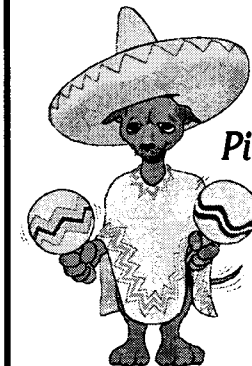



# PAST/OUT

## What were Boston marriages?

December 1879 (120 years ago this month): At a literary gathering in Boston, writer Sarah Orne Jewett meets Annie Adams Fields, her companion for the next 30 years.

In his novel *The Bostonians* (1886), Henry James modeled the relationship between his characters Olive and Verena on what he called "those friendships between women so common in New England." The "friendships" James observed were intimate, long-term relationships between two unmarried women, who were often feminists. Though dubbed "Boston marriages," these relationships occurred throughout the country.

With the growth of cities and an urban middle class in the mid-19th century, opportunities that had been previously unavailable to women began to emerge. As women's colleges were founded and previously all-male schools began to admit women, many middle- and upper-class women left their parents' homes, received an education, and embarked on careers. Many of these women also became politically motivated through the social movements of the time, including the fights for the abolition of slavery, temperance, and woman suffrage. "New Women," as they were called, could for the first time choose to remain unmarried and pursue their own goals and interests.

Many of these women enjoyed circles of like-minded female friends. Within these networks, two women might pair off in a close relationship in which they shared housing, living expenses, vacations, and often a bed. These women were much more than "roommates"; they were soulmates and partners, married in spirit and mind. In *The Bostonians*, Olive "proposes" to Verena this way: "Will you be

my friend, my friend of friends, beyond everyone, everything, forever and ever?" These intimate friendships were socially acceptable, and women in Boston marriages were often recognized as couples by their families, friends, and colleagues.

Some of the most accomplished and prominent women of that era lived in Boston marriages. Most often they were white, though there are also records of African-American female couples. For example, Lucy Diggs Slowe, the first dean of women at Howard University, shared her life with writer Mary Powell Burrill, who had earlier been intimate friends with Harlem Renaissance poet Angelina Weld Grimké.

Many women in Boston marriages were prominent in education, social work, women's rights, and the arts. M. Carey Thomas became the president of Bryn Mawr College when her wealthy philanthropist partner, Mary Elizabeth Garrett, offered the trustees of the school a hefty endowment to entice them to appoint Thomas. During her tenure, Thomas was responsible for turning Bryn Mawr from a finishing school into a college where "girls can learn, can reason, can compete with men in the grand fields of literature, science, and conjecture." Thomas and Garrett shared a home on campus for more than 20 years.

Jane Addams co-founded Chicago's Hull House, one of the country's first settlement houses, with Ellen Gates Starr, her intimate companion since college. When she and Starr grew apart, Addams began a 40-year relationship with another Hull House colleague, Mary Rozet Smith. Addams always brought Smith along on her lecture tours and was in the habit of wiring ahead

to hotels to make sure they reserved a double bed.

Founder of the League of Women Voters, Carrie Chapman Catt outlived two husbands and then shared the latter part of her life with Mary Garrett Hay, a colleague from the suffrage movement. Hay's death in 1928 "shook Mrs. Catt to the soul," one friend recalled. When Catt died 19 years later, she was buried in the same cemetery plot as Hay under a joint tombstone that reads, "Here lie two, united in friendship for 38 years through constant service to a great cause."

Perhaps the best-known of all Boston marriages is the relationship of Sarah Orne Jewett and Annie Adams Fields. Jewett, a fiction writer from Maine, was a devoted feminist who early on rejected heterosexual marriage as destructive to a woman's identity and creativity. Her first novel, *Deephaven* (1877), depicted a romantic friendship between two young women who dreamed about living together like the Ladies of Llangollen, an 18th-century Welsh couple.

In December 1879, Jewett attended a literary reception in Boston at which she met Fields, the wife of *Atlantic Monthly* editor James Fields. The two women became friends instantly, and when Fields's husband died in 1881, she and Jewett formed a Boston marriage. Jewett kept the family home she had inherited in Maine, and for five months out of the year, she stayed there alone,

writing full time. The two women wrote letters back and forth almost daily, calling each other names like "dear love" and expressing their loneliness for each other.

Then, during the rest of the year, "Mrs. Fields and Miss Jewett" lived together in Boston, hosting a literary salon attended by many of the greatest writers of the day, including James himself, Ralph Waldo Emerson, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, and on one occasion Charles Dickens. Their friends included a support network of other couples in Boston marriages, for example, novelist Willa Cather and her partner Edith Lewis. Jewett and Fields remained intimate companions until Jewett's death in 1909.

Whether these relationships were typically sexual in nature is unknown, though among the wider society they were (and generally continue to be) presumed to be asexual. With the rise of scientific and medical inquiry into sexuality in the first decades of the 20th century, these close, loving friendships between women came under sharp scrutiny and began to be pathologized as "female inversion."

"So far, no one has contacted us about the availability of a Furby or a Beanie Baby," laughs Strom, "but we understand the concerns of Toys 'R' Us and, naturally, we do not wish to cause any damage to something they've been building up for over 35 years. We understand the importance of a good brand name and we will change the name of the offending section of our website."

Last year, Toys "R" Us lost a similar court action against Mr. Feinberg, a firearms retailer and his website called gunsareus.com.

"Although we have no objections to complying with the wishes of Toys 'R' Us, I think maybe someone should point out to their legal department that sometimes a simple friendly phone call can be just as effective, considerably more amicable and achieve even faster results than going in guns-a-blazing with demands and threats of legal action," says Storm.

Approximately a thousand people, including 200 performers, participated in the World AIDS Day observance staged Nov. 30 at the Weidner Center on the campus of UW-Green Bay by the Green Bay/Fox Valley-based Entertainers Against AIDS.

The *Green Bay Press-Gazette's* Warren Gerds Dec. 2 critique of the show carried the headline - 'AIDS show at Weidner amuses, moves, amazes.' 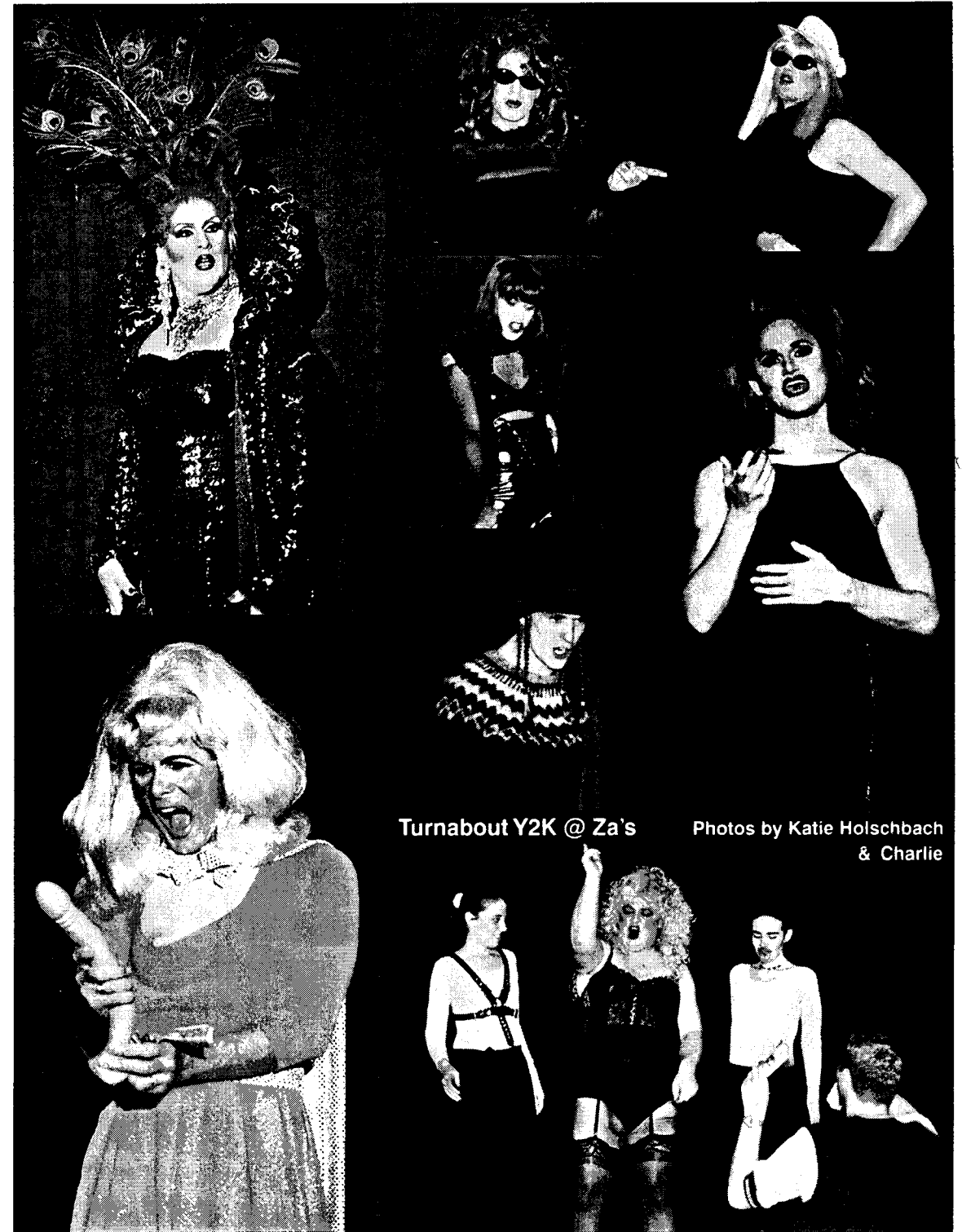
